Class Descriptions

Creative Movement (Ages 3 & 4) Dancers will explore the fundamental locomotor movements of hop, gallop, skip, leap, and jump as well as beginner ballet technique through song and dance!

Pre-Ballet (Ages 4) For 4 year olds, Pre-Ballet is the stepping stone into our dance classes for 5&6 year olds. Pre-ballet uses songs and play to introduce young dancers to traditional ballet training in a fun, age-appropriate way.

Ballet (Ages 5 - 16) Traditional Ballet technique and training for all ages that uses the barre, center combinations, & n across the floor movement.

- Ballet I (For ages 5 & 6)
- Ballet II (For ages 7 14) who have taken 1 3 years of Ballet Technique
- Ballet III (For ages 10 16) who have taken 3 6 years of Ballet Technique

Ballet/Tap I (Ages 5 & 6) A combo class that explores traditional ballet training and fundamental tap dance techniques.

Hip & Flip (Ages 4 - 7, open level) A combination of Hip Hop dance moves and beginner Acrobatics!

Broadway Jazz I (Ages 7 - 14) Jazz technique using center and across the floor movement set to your favorite Broadway Music!

- Broadway Jazz I (For ages 7 10) who are beginner or have taken 1 3 years of dance
- Broadway Jazz II (For ages 11 16) who are intermediate or have taken 3 or more years of dance

Contemporary/Jazz (Ages 7 - 15) Contemporary and Jazz technique using center and across the floor movement.

- Contemporary/Jazz I (For ages 7 10) who are beginner or have taken 1 3 years of dance
- Contemporary/Jazz II (For ages 11 16) who are intermediate or have taken 3 or more years of dance

Hip Hop This fun and upbeat class teaches the fundamentals of hip hop, hip hop music, and some breakdancing!

- Hip Hop I (For ages 7 12) who are beginner or have taken 1 2 years of dance)
- Hip Hop II (For ages 10 16) who have taken 3 years of dance or more)

Singing for Musical Theatre (Ages 8-16) Learn basic technique for healthy musical theatre singing! Sing favorites from iconic musicals and find your voice in a supportive environment. Class will cover musical theatre concepts like healthy belting, using chest and head voice, "speak singing", and projection.

Theatre I (Ages 7-14) Students learn the basics of building a character through such activities as pantomime, improvisation, and effective speaking using articulation, projection, and breathing. Students will also explore the use of such elements as costumes, props, and scenery.

Dress Code

Creative Movement: Footless tights or leggings with leotards or tight fitting t-shirts and bare feet or ballet shoes. Hair should be secured away or in a bun if possible.

Pre-Ballet: School of the Arts **required leotard**, full length pink tights, pink ballet shoes. Dancers of color are supported and encouraged in wearing flesh toned tights and ballet shoes.

Male Identifying Dancers: black bike shorts, tights or leggings, plain colored T-shirt with white ballet shoes (socks should match the color of the shoes)

Hair should be secured in a bun.

Ballet, Ballet/Tap: School of the Arts **required leotard**, optional matching skirt, pink tights, pink ballet shoes. Dancers of color are supported and encouraged to wear flesh toned tights and shoes.

Male Identifying Dancers: White t-shirts, black tights or bike shorts, black or white socks, white ballet shoes (socks should match the color of the shoes).

Hair should be secured in a bun.

Jazz/Contemporary: School of the Arts **required leotard** with black leggings, black tights, or black shorts. Tan jazz shoes. Male Identifying Dancers White short, black leggings or shorts with black jazz shoes. Hair should be secured in a bun.

Hip Hop, Hip & Flip: Sneakers, any clothing. No bra tops. School of the Arts **required leotard** for Hip & Flip. Hair should be secured in a bun or pony tail.

Broadway Jazz: School of the Arts **required leotard** with black leggings, black tights, or black shorts. Tan jazz shoes. Male Identifying Dancers White short, black leggings or shorts with black jazz shoes. Hair should be secured in a bun.

Theatre and Voice: Clothing that is easy to move in. Black Jazz Shoes.

PAYMENT Information

- Our season runs from August to May 10th. Registering your child for class implies a full season commitment.
- Your tuition for the entire season is split into 9 payments.
 - $\circ~$ Each payment is due on the first day of each month starting in August.
 - $\circ~$ Your last tuition payment is in April. (There is no tuition charged in May.)
- The Studio Athens prefers that tuition be auto-paid monthly.
 - If you choose to pay otherwise, there will be a \$5.00 increase in the monthly tuition.
 - Tuition is late after the 15th, and will result in a \$20 late fee.
- There is a \$25 registration fee for currently enrolled students who register during priority registration (April 8 14) and a \$30 registration for new students and after the April 14th date.
- Tuition is not prorated or refunded for missed classes. We also cannot offer make-up classes for student missed classes.
- A 10% discount will be given to any parent interested in paying for the season in full.**No refunds.

PAYING TUITION

There are FOUR ways to pay tuition at The Studio Athens.

- 1. ENROLL IN AUTO-PAY: This is our preferred way to pay tuition- it comes out every month on the 1st day of the month. Please choose ENROLL IN AUTO-PAY once you are in the parent portal linked above. If you choose not to enroll in auto-pay, there will be a \$5 increase in your monthly tuition.
- 2.PAY ONLINE: You can log-in to your parent portal here: <u>https://dancestudio-pro.com/online/thestudioath</u> and click MAKE PAYMENT.
- 3. PAY IN PERSON AT THE STUDIO: You can pay with a credit card or check when you bring your child to class. Please see our front desk admin for assistance.
- 4. PAY IN FULL: For your convenience, we can take the entire year's tuition in one lump sum. There is a 10% discount for paying your tuition in full! This removes the need to remember payment dates. If this might work for you, let us know!

Recital

All Youth Recreational Classes will be required to participate in our May 10th recital.

- There will be a one time costume fee of \$85 will be due in December 2024.
- All dancers will be required to attend the Dress Rehearsal the week of recital. Location and time TBD.

Withdrawal from Class

To withdraw from class, The Studio must receive a written request of withdrawal 5 days prior to the tuition withdrawal date to thestudio.athens@gmail.com. Otherwise, you will be charged for the next month regardless of whether or not you attend class.

This charge is non-refundable. Doctor's notes for injuries will be accepted. Tuition (paid in full, installments, monthly), registration fees, and costume payments are non-refundable.
